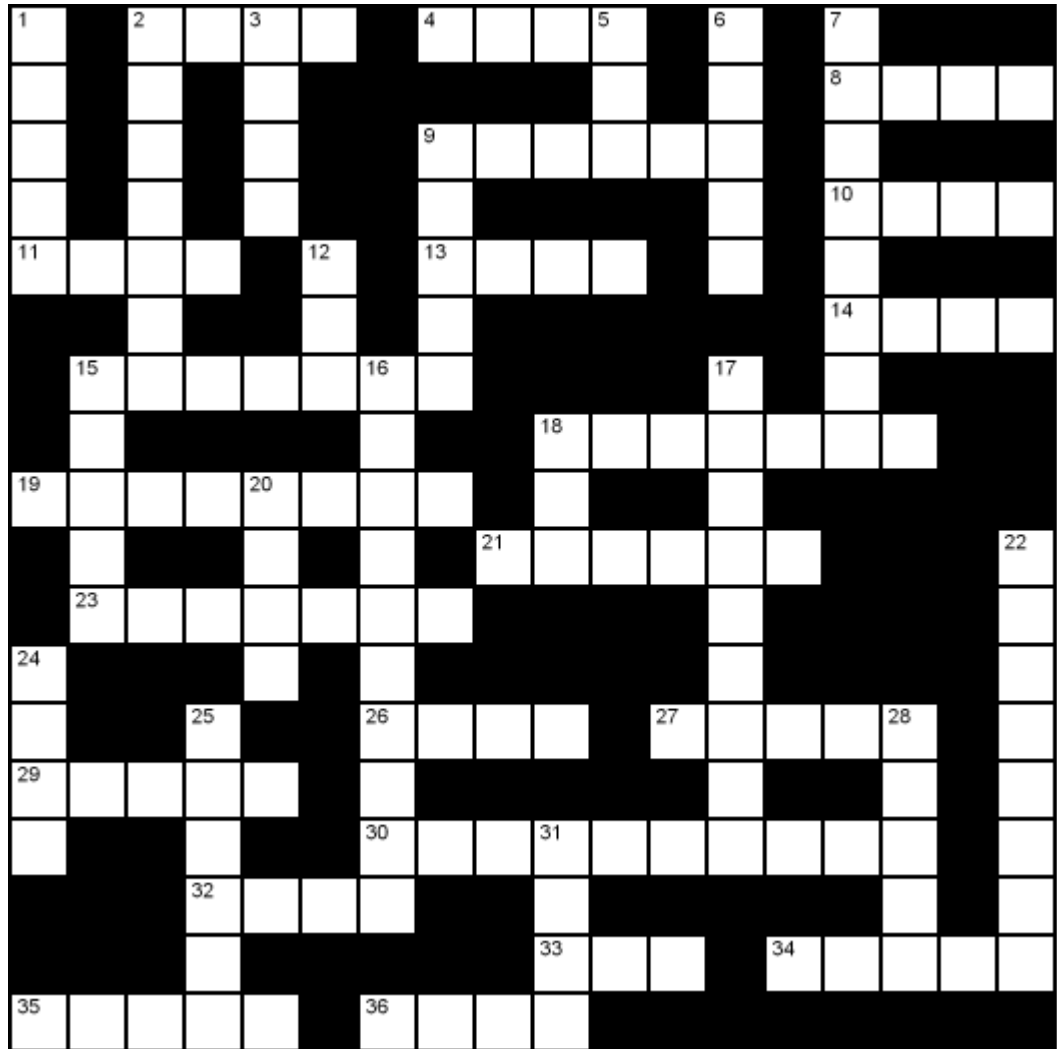


A11d Pray in Your Room, Matthew 6:1-6;16-18, Ash Wednesday
