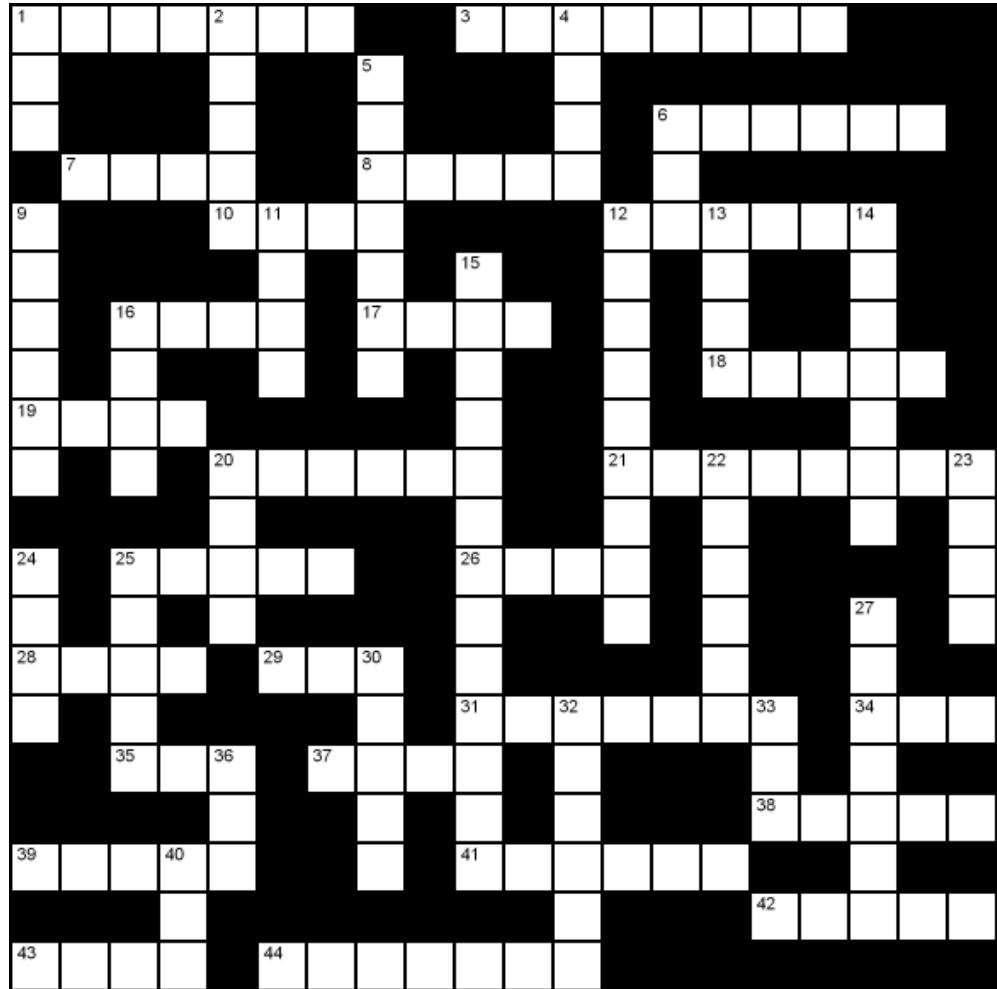


A25a Serve Only One Master, Matthew 6:24-34 Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time
