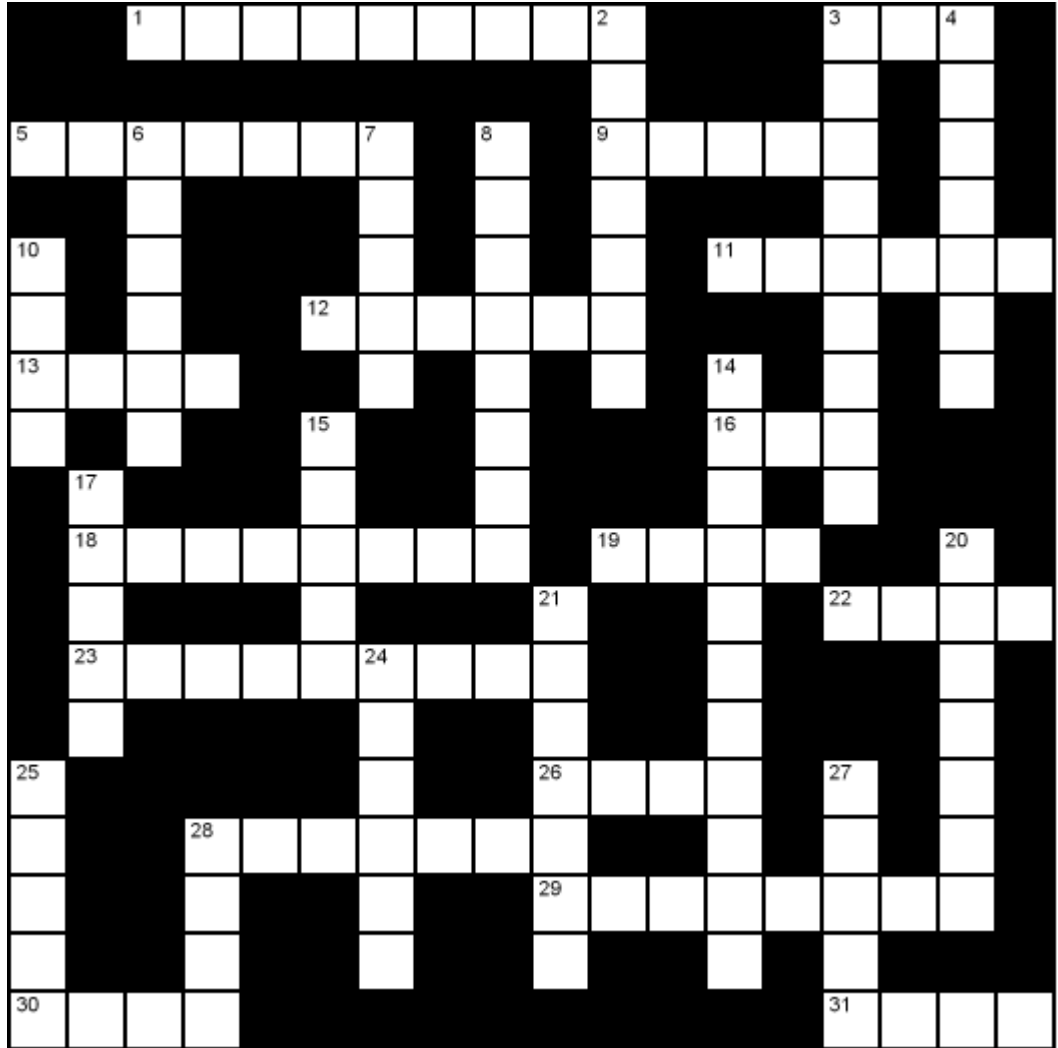


A29 Sheep with No Shepherd, Matthew 9:36-38;10-1-8, Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
