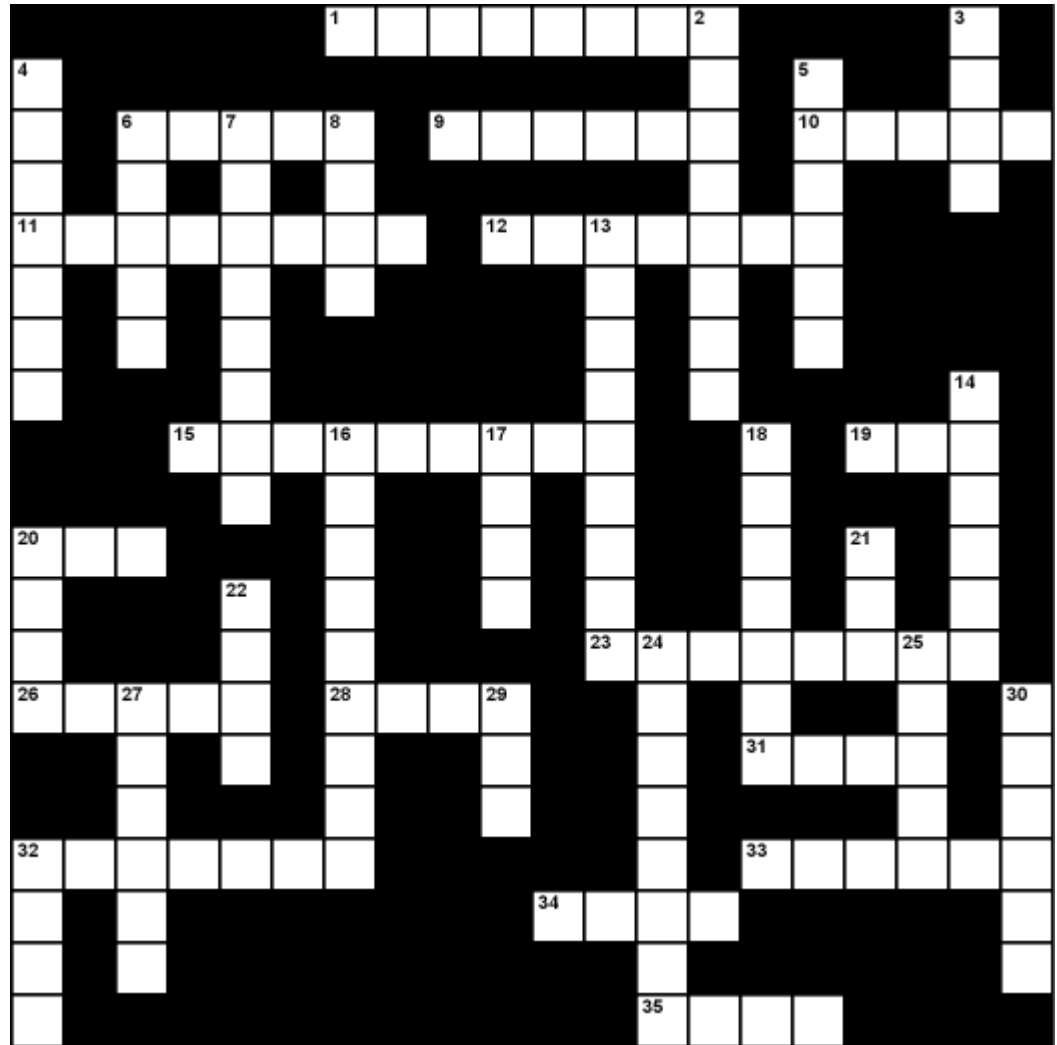


A30 Even the Hairs on Your Head Are Counted, Matthew 10:26-33, Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time
