

A35 Good Fish Are Put into Buckets, Matthew 13:44-52 Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

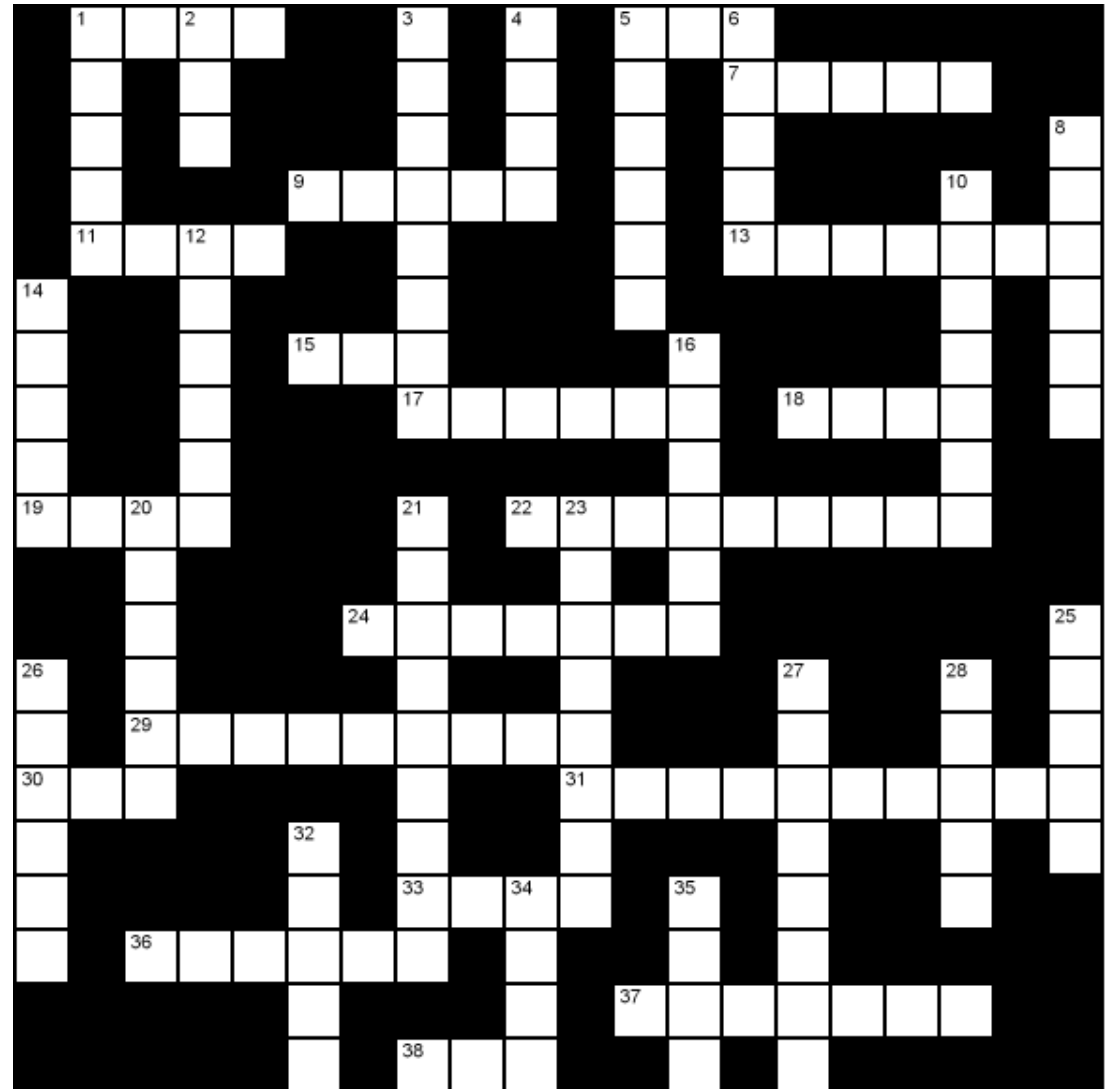
